The case has increased until total tissues loss (Pick Nose), Oral, Nasal mucosae are involved small, soft gray, ulcers, pink papules bleed easily. Pressure with a glass slide shows small yellowish-brown spots. The diagnosed was cutaneous Leishmaniasis test. The patient had been treated with glucantim for one year no improvement has been occurred. The patient had been treated with anti-tuberculosis drugs. Biopsy and plastic surgery has done.
