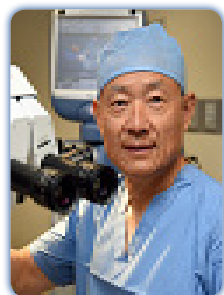

Modern refractive cataract surgery: Foundation and options

Cataract surgery is no longer simple vision rehabilitation any more. More and more patients require or even demand postoperative spectacle independence.
