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Fertility conservation, how to maximize the outcome

Over the past few decades, there has been a trend to delay pregnancy and childbearing. The advancement in contraceptive methods and social acceptability has supported this trend and as a result childbearing age has been delayed from the 20's to the 30's and early 40's. In this seminar, I will discuss several conditions and scenarios that would arise as result of delaying fertility such as fibroids and endometriosis, their impact on fertility and whether surgical intervention would improve outcome. I will also address the assessment of ovarian reserve as well the timing and technology for fertility preservation.
