## Orthodontic microimplant for distalization of mandibular dentition in class III correction

Treatment of class III without crowding use implant was used for distalization for lower dentition. Every orthodontic tooth movement is accompanied by a reaction. This can make it difficult to correct a malocclusion by using intraoral appliances alone, especially when complete distal movement of the mandibular dentition is planned in nonsurgical Class III malocclusion treatment. Traditionally, fixed appliances and intermaxillary elastics have been used to move mandibular molars distally, often resulting in undesirable proclination of the maxillary incisors and extrusion of the maxillary molars as reciprocal side effects.
