Assessment of Risk factors of Age Related Macular Degeneration attending a tertiary care hospital in Assam, India.

Purpose: To study the risk factors and compare their patterns in relation to ARMD in patients above 50 years attending Department of Ophthalmology, AMCH. Materials and Methods:63 cases and 63 controls were enrolled in this case control study. These were subjected to a questionnaire based on the important potential risk factors and their association was calculated using Chi Square test. Results: Hypertension, current tobacco consumption, alchohol consumption, previous cataract surgeris and high BMI were found to be statistically significant risk factors. Conclusion: This case control study confirms some of the risk factors previously identified and may contribute to their proper understanding in an effort to halt it's development and progression.
