


In China, kidney transplantation is about \$70,000, liver \$160,000, and heart \$120,000. Although these prices are still

In 2018, the global market for organ transplantation was 67 million US\$ and is expected to reach 86 million US\$ by the end of 2025, with a CAGR of 10 per cent between 2019 and 2025.
