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## Penoscrotal Incision for Implanting Penile Prosthesis

The surgical procedure of hydraulic (three-piece inflatable penile prosthesis) penile implant is a valid option in the treatment of erectile dysfunction who have not gotten results from other types of treatments.

This operation is minimally invasive because it's done in 30 minutes; involve only 4 cm incision and few days off from work. The operation is generally carried out under regional anesthesia.

Satisfaction of patients and good quality of sexual life has been reported. Penile prosthesis does not change sensation on the skin of the penis or a man's ability to reach orgasm. The ejaculation is not affected.

Complications of penile prosthesis surgery are infection (in 1 to 3 percent of cases) and risk of mechanical failure.
