During the calendar year of 2019, JPB received a total of 34 manuscripts, out of which 6 articles (20%) were rejected in the preliminary screening due to plagiarism or being out of the format

and peer review process. During 2019 around 25 articles were subjected for publication after they are accepted in the peer review process. In the 12 issues of Volume 12 published during the year 2019, a total of 25 articles were published. Articles were published from authors all around the world. Globally articles have been accessed by the research scientists and also cited.

Journal of Proteomics & Bioinformatics also announces its new association with Longdom group for Archiving, Journal maintenance, financial purpose and support. However the journal will be running its original website <https://www.longdom.org/proteomics-bioinformatics.html> parallel for Editorial and review work process so as to maintain its highest standard of scientific work.

I am pleased to mention that during the year 2019, all issues of volume 12 were published online well within the time and the print issues were also brought out and dispatched within 30 days of publishing the issue online.
